One girl child aged 1year 3 month had in red zone, after noticed that the RBSK (RASHTRIYA BAL SWASTHYA KARYAKARM) takes care of her.</p>

Career counseling to 26 High schools and Personal health and.
To give orientation for the 25 adolescent club members about their health, hygienic and decision making capacity. This program will conduct a well resource person and followed by GC staff.

This year GC has decided to cover all H.S (42) in Hindol block of Personal skill development training program. Mr. Samir Ranjan Dash (Mass Education Minister of Odisha) had inaugurated the career planner in Jaydev Bhaban, BBSR. But due to late date of inauguration of career planner, exam and the biggest problem of COVID 19 we covered only 24nos of schools. In this training program concern School both 9th and 10th class boys with girls (601+839=1440), School teachers and outside members are participated, but we only gave importance to 10th class students, one to one career counseling to (84 boys+120 girls=204nos) only 10th students. We gave the life coping skill development training to the adolescent students in 26 no of High School because the village parents are unaware about the changes of adolescent in this period so we give training to the student to handle this age carefully. During this period we gave 25nos of “orientation for the adolescent club members” in High school in phase wise. 18nos of students have interested towards commerce, whereas most of all girls are interested towards fashion design course study due to this program me the teachers of 10nos of schools and some parents are appreciated for this program me and also for planner, charts.
