Chronicle of GC:-

Ganeswar Club is known as GC, a volunteer organization. It is a volunteer organization. Group of local youths were together on **NATIONAL YOUTH DAY**, so they were passion with the change of quality of lives of the poor and downtrodden in the remote areas of Dhenkanal district. To notice the effort of youths **Mr.Ganeswar Mishra** had donate a piece of land to them. So all the people of that time decided to name it as **“Ganeswar Club”** and it got its legal entity in 19th September 1980.After registered it connected with **Nehru Yuba Kendra** to do youth activities. Gradually it contacted OREDA, BBSR for smokeless Chula activity and NEAC programs of the ministry of Forests, Environment, Govt. of India. In the year 1987 the organization accorded the FC registration to get financial support from abroad. Due to its involvement in socio-economic activities, it first time get the ZEE from Gandhi Peace Center. Then we were getting support from TDH, CWS, HIVOS and GOVT. of India. On the above basis it gradually developed its activities. Through these activities they involved in the educational and economically develop of poor people. GC has today matured, working with approximately 30,000 more than families, spreading its spectrum of activities, reaching the other district such as Cuttack.

In such a critical socio-economic scene, **GC** extends its helping hand to each individual victim and tries to wipe out the tears and to alleviate the agony.

GC working mostly with the very lower class people of the society, who is unaware about the Education, Health, Sanitation as well as Govt. facilities, which is only avail for them. The village communities are unaware about the importance of AWC. The communities who are in the member of MC/JC will check the regularity and functioning of AWC. MC members are taking their responsibility. Apart from that we covered 167 AWCs out of them we formed MJ/JC in 151 AWCS to maintain covid guideline. Others cannot form because those centres are quarantine centres. Pick out all problems and find out solution, divided responsibility between active leader, AWW and AWH. Through this activity we can succeed more in our work. There are 3 categories of beneficiaries in AWC. First- Second- 0-3 year child Pregnant woman Third- 3-6 year child In this activity we explain to people about the important of THR and its use.
Intervention with AWCs by Community Mobilizer (grade B and C level AWCs -93)	In Odisha, the whole year all the education institution had closed, but the few time it is reopen from 7 th February 2021 to 19 th April 2021. But the duration of AWC is 7:30 to 9:00. In this time, some parents did not agreed to send their children due to covid 19 and other parents are send to tuition after personal counselling and mothers meeting they send them. After bad luck the increase of second wave of covid 19, it was closed.
Enrolment/ attendance monitoring in AWCs by 6nos Community Mobilizer	The major component of ICDS is monitoring and reduction of malnutrition among the 0-6 year's children of state. Any organizations success is determined by how punctual its employee, student, teacher also, During this year GC work with 167nos AWC including MINI AWC 20. For AWC there is a specific time for opening and closing but still now it was seen some AWW/AWH are coming too late like this some children coming in time and some not in time. That's why our 6nos of community mobilizer visit these centre twice or thrice in one month, and noticed their hygienic, centre arrangements, pre education process to the children, absentee student's personal meet, home visit etc.

Monthly village meeting in 64 villages/hamlets.	By bringing together a cross section of viewpoints. A community meeting is the perfect setting to exchange ideas and information, grant community groups real opportunities to affect plans and make changes and gives them responsibility as part of the process so that they feel their efforts will matter. Community participation can be loosely defined as the involvement of people in a community in projects to solve their own problems. Community participation is especially important in emergency sanitation programmers where people may be unaccustomed to their surrounding and new sanitation facilities.
Develop TLM in 30nos AWCs as CDF model.	CDF training is the best training for AWCs, Which is very helpful for preschool children. The objective of the program me was quality educational activities for AWCs. As per last year training, we selected 15nos of old and new 15nos of AWC as CDF Model AWC. Through these activities all the children grow in their mental, physical and moral stage and also more involvement of MC/JC/parents.
Functional ECCE day	Because of covid 19 pandemic situation, in our area AWCs had opened only for 2 hour. So in this duration it is impossible to functioning ECCE Day . Still in our total area 3nos of AWC (Bhanupada, Katakul, Badagula) had functioning this day and involved parents/MC/JC members/and also grandparents of children.
Nutrition supplement distribution	All of our AWC properly distribute their THR to preschool children, ANC/PNC. Due to lock down period our staff specifically mentioned in THR part and in some problematic area, they solved it.
Issues identified to Supervisor/CDPO-ICDS matter with result	This is the platform where all the changes will happen. In our area there are some problems still arise, where as we need the help of SUPERVIOR and Child Development Project Officer (CDPO) to solve this. Apart from this people also direct contact with them for solve their problems.
Primary / Upper Primary Schools	
Enrolment and attendance monitoring	Some students are come to school in time and some are not coming in time. For that reason our Community Mobilizer monitoring of school in every month. We are monitoring the attendance & enrolment of village and school. We enroll those children who are not enrolling in school in respective to their age. We check the attendance in School to identify the absent student as well as the long absent student. After the identification they went to met them to know about the real cause for which he/she was absent. In case of cheating or long absence we motivate the child as well as motivate their parents for send their child to school. Apart from that we suffered more problem due to school closed.
Appointment of 3nos Para teacher	We give this service in 03 nos. of schools. Our Para teacher takes the whole responsibility of class 1 &2 with some times attend other classes. So the Para teacher can make a strong base of these children .Our Para teacher is not only strengthen the education but also strengthen the extracurricular activities and works as a community mobilize. They met to community once in a week & they are doing home visit to respective person for last one hour of the working period. They also conduct all monthly meeting in village level, ICDS level and school level. In covid pandemic situation, the schools have closed so our para had stared the hamlet teaching center in 4nos area.
Reenrollments of dropout children	In our covered area there are 4nos of students have enrolled in this year. This is all because of personal counseling to their parents and also them. These children also involved in CRC activity, where we focus on regularize of children to school. All the children should be read and write. These children influenced by CRC activities. We took the permission from D.E.O and admitted them in school. Out of four students 3nos are 10 th class and one in 9 th .
Supply of Science kits to 10nos UPS	We arranged a meeting on science kit supply and its use, where 34nos of teachers. Mr.Santanu Kumar Malick B.E.O. of Hindol block, Mr Naresh Chandra Behera Additional B.E.O Mr. Bijaya Krishna Panda is the Science coordinator of ILP of this programme. In this programme he divided all the teachers in 4 groups and told them that each group will do 5nos of experiment. After that each group shared their views on experiment. Apart from that Coordinator also shared other experiments to teacher.

Club members were able to single out the different entices in charge of children affairs in the communities and these included the police, local leader, court, NGOs and the teachers in the school. There are 25 to 40 members in this committee from 4th class to +2 levels with drop out children. Then choose a name for this committee named as on legend. There are selected four/Five active members for team leading in different hamlet, because they are summoning every child when we are arriving. This year we are taken some new step for CRC members.</p>

And 7th class students. With all the covid SOP we had conducted LLA, where the village president, ward member and also parents involved. There are 61+69=144nos of students in 4th class, 76+65=161nos of 5th class students and 54+66=142nos of 7th class students had appeared the exam.</p>

After that discussion we provided the career planner. In this training Program student are participate and put some different type of questions. Mr. Rajendra Kumar Pal (Secretary of GC), Lisa Pradhan, Miss SushriSwagatika Rout and Miss Meena Biswal were joined as Resource persons for orientation program.
Support to 15nos scholarship for higher study	GC works in interior tribal area where girl's child education ratio is very poor. Day by day importance of the girl child education became decreased. Tribal people are un aware regarding value of education. They are giving more importance to immediate earning money only in present situation not to sustainability earning money through education.

World Environment Day:-

World environment day is held each year on June 5. It promotes ways to improve the Earth's environment. GC also promotes this activity in every year. This year that program me will be hold by GC in office campus. Where 19nos of people had gave hands for help. At first all the staffs cleaned the total surrounding of GC office, planted 10nos of different types of saplings.

Women's Day:-

Women's Day is celebration on 8th March and it also plays a vital role in every society. Ganeswar club also gives emphasis on this, that's why it organized a meeting in Bankatia village to celebrate that day, where 67nos of participants were attended. There were women and adolescent girls. Where the chief guest Mrs. Ritarani Naik, **ZILLA PARISADA** of zone no.4. Firstly we arranged a rally with some flash card on basis of women empowerment and girl child education, benefits of SHGs, Higher study of girls, book support, Child marriage, gender inequality and so on topics were discussed and finally some games were played by members and gave prizes to them.

Farm School Training:-

Floriculture or flower farming is a discipline of horticulture concerned with the cultivation of flowering and ornamental plants for gardens and for floristry. Farm school training on floury culture had organized in GC office twice on 12/06/2020 and 02/09/2020 where 32nos of farmers had attended. Mrs. Sasmita Sahu, AHO, Hindol, Samir Kumar Pattnaik ATM, Hindol, Suresh Chandra Sahu as trainer. In first phase they were learnt about the plantation and production of flowers and in 2nd phase there were distributed sapling and cinture.

Orientation to Youth and Members of GC:-

An orientation programmer held on 06/09/2020 in GC offence with the youth and members of Bankatia village, where 34nos of participants had attended. Mr. Srinibas Mishra, the president of GC elaborated the origin of organization. And then 3nos of staffs are discussed about child right, child marriage, scholarship, higher study leadership quality etc. Then some game played by them on the basis of leadership.

Sisu Samaprka Jatra:-

Sisu Sampark Jatra program me had held on 20/01/2021 in Giridharprasad Panchayat office. Where the **DCPO** of CWC Mrs. Anuradha Goswami, President of CHILDLINE Mr. Sanjay Moharana, Mrs Monalisisa Sahoo, member of SAKHI and member of SOVA had attended the meeting. This meeting had held in Giridharprasad. All the AWWs, SHG women, children and also adolescent girls of this G.P. Rajendra Kumar Pal, the Secretary of Ganeswar Club and other 5nos of staffs were attended this program me. During covid pandemic situation in all society there were more affected on children. So the vehicle chariot on children was inaugurated by the COLLECTOR of Dhenkanal district. This chariot was worshipped thrice time in phase wise such as Babandha harijanasahi, Barhmpur and Bedapada. In this meeting discussed about child labor, dropout student, child marriage, unwanted mother, gender discrimination, malnutrition had a social disease for children.

Exposure Visit:-

Exposure visit are a very important training methodology as it enables the participants from a different setting interact with band learn from each other, allowing them to view practical/real life situations of successful integration of sustainable practices. All the MSW students of Biju Pattanik College of Hotel Management and Journalism had exposure to our organization on 03/04/2021. They interacted with Sabarsahi AWC, Sisusabha and Matru meeting and
